Lesson 3 Use What You Have



Read Luke 9:12-17



After so many wonderful things Jesus did for the apostles they must have wanted to do whatever they could for him in return. One day, after the Lord had been teaching a large crowd on a hillside, Andrew came to him and said, "It is getting late, Lord, and the people have nothing to eat. We should tell them to go home." But Jesus said "Give them to eat."

In the Gospel of John it tells us that a little boy had brought with him 5 loaves of bread and 2 small fish but he was <u>willing to share</u> them [John 6:9] So Jesus said for everyone to sit down and he prayed to bless this simple gift. The apostles passed the small amount of food around to all those people. When everyone was finished they collected what was left and had twelve baskets full! A great miracle happened because one little boy <u>gave</u> to the Lord <u>all he had</u>!!
